Date/ Time: Wednesday, July 14th, 2010. 12:00pm start.

Location: Dalton HS 1500 Manly Street Dalton, Ga. 30720

Warm-ups: Open warm-up will be from 9:30a.m. to 11:30 a.m. The board will be closed at 11:30 a.m. for 8 and under boys and girls only. Each event warm-up will be 30 minutes prior to their start time. Girls and boys will be run together.

Facility: One 1M Durafirm stand and DuraFlex board. The pool depth is 12.6 ft. There is plenty available parking at Dalton High School.

Rules: 2010 USA Diving rules will apply unless otherwise stated by the 2010 CASL. Note: Divers will enter the event corresponding to his/her age as of June 1st, 2010.

Entry Fee: \$10.00 per diver

CASL Surcharge: \$6.00 per diver or swimmer in the meet. (This is a one- time fee for all swimmers and divers).

Entry Deadline: All HY-TEK diving entries are due on Monday, July, 12th, 2010. The event file can be found at: ccacswimming.org— Please look for HOSTED MEETS and scroll down for the 51st Annual City Meet Diving. A “Psych Sheet” will be placed on same web address, after all entries are received.

Items to be turned in on meet day:

All diving hard copies need to be turned in by 10:00am on the date of the meet (July 14th, 2010).Hard copies consist of: Team Waiver and Diver Entries, Entry fees, and DIVING FORM. Changes can be made up to 30 minutes prior to that diver’s competition. Please use pencils on diving forms.

Late Entries: Late entries can be made up to 10:00am on the day of the meet. The fee will double for all late entries (All entries after July 12th will be considered “Late”).

Awards: 1st-8th place will receive medals with 9th-16th place receiving ribbons.

Scoring: Points will be awarded for the top 16 places in each event. The point values are as follows: 20, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13,12,11,9,7,6,5,4,3,2,and 1. These points will be added to the FINAL TEAM SCORES at the conclusion of the swimming competition.

Hospitality: CCAC will provide hospitality for all coaches and officials.

Concessions: A full concession stand will be provided for all divers and spectators.
